DESCRIPTION

1920's detached 2 storey family house in mature garden with topiary trimmed yew hedges. Two storey front gable bay windows give this house the distinctive 1920's design with dominant roof to the right swooping down to the ground floor window heads. A bedroom extension above the integral garage with flat leaded roof in part compromises the original design. Well-kept front gardens add to the elegance.
