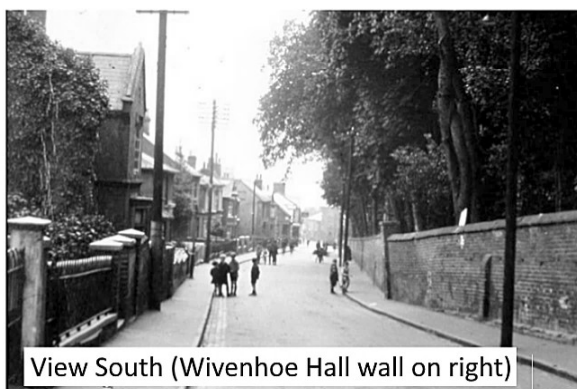


WIVENHOE HIGH STREET 100 YEARS AGO

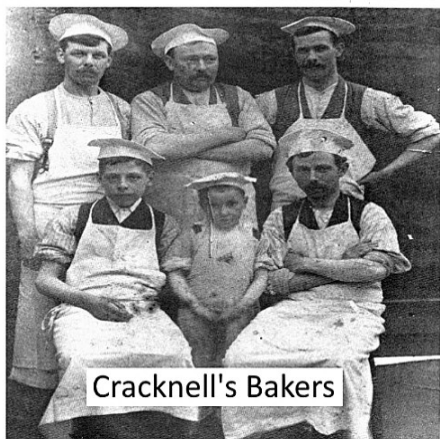
View South (Wivenhoe Hall wall on right)

View Up High Street



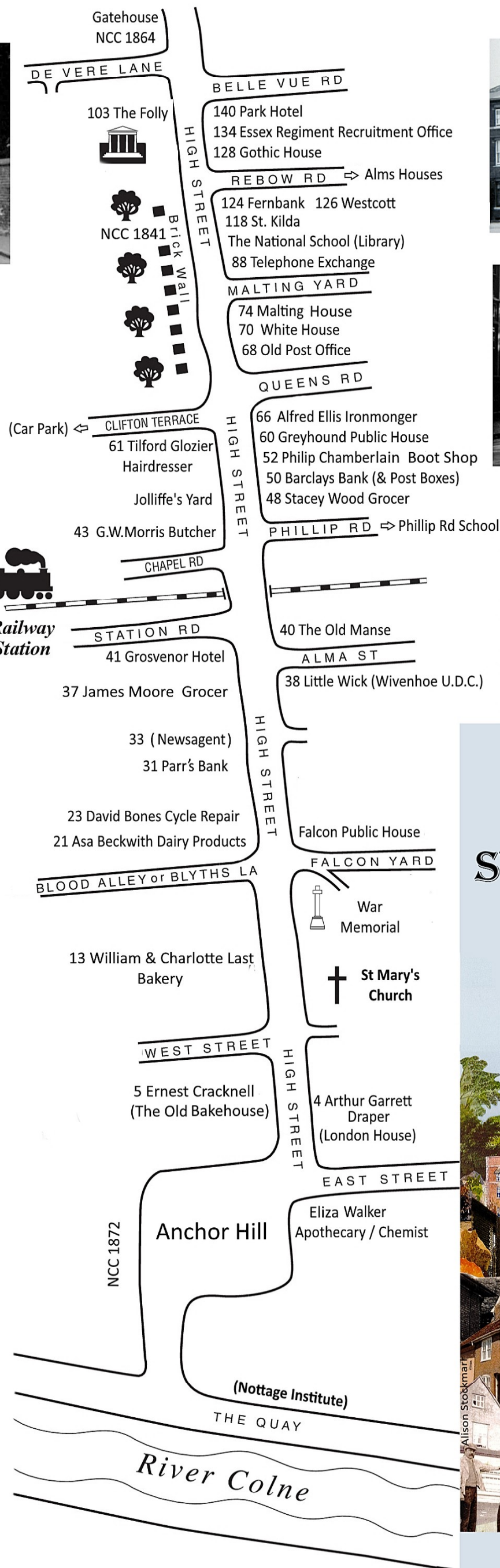

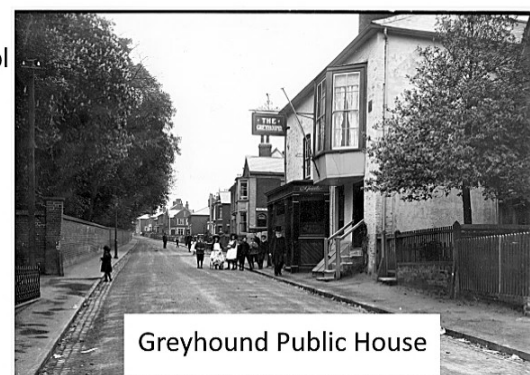
