 poundes be due. Item I owe unto one John Hery the younger of Lysleton four poundes and  
 a half of shate to be paid our Lady daie next wher my will is shalbe discharged allso  
 Item I owe unto Jeremy Cay of London all the signe of the thre Lyons aboute some fyfte  
 shillinge as will appere upon his booke wher my will is shalbe paid allso. My goodes  
 lymge at dyverse places some at Haman in John Burnelle house other at Wodlington in  
 Sainte Marthe in M<sup>r</sup> harys house. Allso one John Bode of Kilmeston hath a clock  
 M<sup>r</sup> Lewis of Norton a pair of ringmalt. In my chamber at London I have a chest a  
 featherbedd and bedstee with furniture and a bedd for my man and duntise booke in my  
 Studie. All wher I would have to be sold or extortyng the booke of entite wher I give  
 unto M<sup>r</sup> John Trypte of Brytton by the advint and counsell of one M<sup>r</sup> Denman dwellinge  
 in litle Sainte Bartholomewes churche my executor to dispose of all this. Item I have two  
 instrumentes of Musket at M<sup>r</sup> Denmans wher I give hym. Allso I have two gownes at M<sup>r</sup>  
 Denmans in litle Sainte Bartholomewes wher I referre to the disposicion of my executor  
 Item I give twentie shillinges to the poore of Bally. Item I give ten shillinges to the

 hode paymte for a fine to my executor forre four poundes and twentie Nobles Francke  
 Bourne. This will was made by the aboutwritten Francke Bourne and wally by  
 me Richard Merdeth parson of the parische in great haste unto all wher I am a

 my will is that that monie no shalbe made of my goodes in my chamber at London  
 be delivred to Jeremy Cay the monie no to some unto me out of Essex for the  
 payment of the debt wher I owe unto Peter Trypte for the wher he standeth bounde  
 and my bond to be taken upp. Allso my desire is that M<sup>r</sup> Denman be carefull to finde out  
 all the writmgs in the booke wher comt me and mint and delivre thm to my

of Downton in the parish of Spton magna in the County of Salop yoman this cleaerly daw of June in the year of our Lord god one thousand sechundred being sit in bedd but of p[er]fect memorie thank be to Almighty god consideringe the p[er]vertauntie of man and life do p[ro]nomit and make my last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge. First I bequeath my soule unto allmightie god my maker and redemer stedfastly belevinge throughe the death and bloodsheddinge of my Saviour Ihesus Christ to be saved And as for my temporall goodes landes Tenementes Chattells Farmes and teninges wherof I have pleased god to bless me my will is to give and dispose of them as hereafter followeth. First I give and bequeath to my wife my daughter so as she be ruled in matrimonye of her selfe and otherwise by my Overseers and Executors or any two of them the some of ffifty poundes of curraunt Englishe moneye otherwise I give her in full satisfaction of her portion a hundred and the other ffortie poundes to be distributed amongst the rest of my chyldey as shall be ruled accordinge to my minde and as shall fortune to be theyn livinge. Item I give and bequeath to Thomas Jone and James other thre of my chyldey so as they be ruled in matrimonye of them selves and otherwise by my Overseers and Executors or any two of them ffortie poundes a p[er]ce of said ffortie poundes to be paid of them. And yf any of them shall not be so ruled theyn my will is that he or they so doinge contrarye to my minde shall have in full satisfaction of his or their portion Ten poundes and the residue to be distributed amongst such of the forefaide severall leagars as my will is shall be paid out of my landes goodes Dornes and p[ar]tiallly to be paid of my said chyldey when they shall accomplish the age of twentie one years or be married in marriage by the advice of my Overseers and Executors as aforesaid or otherwise theyn meete. And my will is that yf any of my said chyldey die before they shall be married in marriage or have accomplished the age of twentie one years that theyn his or their portion to be distributed amongst the rest of my said chyldey as shall be ruled and be ruled as aforesaid. And as touching my landes and Tenementes wherof I have in the County of Flint my will is that the same beinge divided into thre equall partes my wife shall have one of the said partes in liewe of her dowre or dower wherof she ought to have out of my landes duringe the tyme of her life. And that the other two partes of the said landes and the benefitt and Rentes therof shall be employed towards the paynge of my forefaide landes untill my sonne John shall accomplish the age of fowre and twentie years and then he to have and enjoy the same Item my will is that the whole Tenement in Downton duringe my said sonne Johns minoritye I mean untill he shall accomplish the forefaide age of fowre and twentie years shall be to the maintenancie of my said wife the keepinge her selfe widowe and of my said sonne John and of the rest of his brethren and Sisters. Item the residue of all my goodes p[ar]tiallly and whatsover I have in my househould stuffe and implementes of husbandrie whatsover the forefaide leagars and the leagars hereafter mentioned discharged the moerth or one halfe the of
